Why do we ask for this information?

The Career & Educational Opportunities Program (C.E.O.) aims to help those in need of assistance who have demonstrated a commitment to their own success. We focus on supporting goals of completing school and maintaining employment and the program is funded through the federal Workforce Investment Act. The program is sometimes able to financially assist participants with fees for certificate testing, books for classes, or other career training.

The following list is the income guidelines we MUST follow. Find the number that matches your family. If your household makes no more than that gross amount per year, you probably qualify to go through our intake and assessment process to make sure the program is appropriate to meet your needs.
