Why should I apply?

- Earn in-demand IT credentials: AWS Solutions Architecture, CompTIA Linux+, Net+
- 16 month program:
 - 4 mo. training + 12 mo. on-the-job training at Amazon's Herndon, VA facility
- Apprentices will be paid during their entire training period, with incremental wage increases as you learn.

To be considered for this opportunity, individuals must:

- Be an honorably discharged veteran, transitioning service member, or military spouse.
 - Currently hold an active CompTIA A+ Certification, or have a background in systems administration.
 - Have an undergraduate or graduate technical degree in Science/Information Technology, Computer Science, Engineering, Mathematics, Physics, or a related field
- OR**
- Have an Associate's Degree in a technical field + 4 years of hands-on technical work experience.
 - The ability to obtain and maintain a Top Secret security clearance with Sensitive Compartmented Information (TS/SCI).
